They study at universities around the world as well as here in Myanmar.

## Primary School, Nursery to Year 6

### Foundation Stage, Key stage 1 and Key Stage 2

The primary school provides a high quality education in a happy, safe environment; taking children on their first steps towards developing the skills of lifelong learning. Students follow an adapted English National Curriculum and teachers promote active, creative learning in a friendly atmosphere.

## Secondary School

### Key Stage 3 (Year 7 to Year 9)

In the secondary school Key Stage 3, Years 7 – 9, students develop the academic foundations needed for success in the IGCSE and A level courses undertaken during Years 10 – 13. Students undertake a rigorous, balanced English style curriculum taught by professional supportive international teachers.

## The English National Curriculum

In the primary school students are taught English, Geography, History, Mathematics, Science, and PSHE by their class teacher. Art, Computing, Mandarin starting from Year 2 onwards. Music, Myanmar and PE are all taught by specialist teachers. Secondary students in Key Stage 3 take all of these subjects.

## English as an Additional Language (EAL)

Students who need extra support with their English will receive personalized support from trained EAL specialist teachers. Our EAL department provides a mixture of in class support and withdrawal lessons to help students improve their English.

These language lessons are compulsory if WIDA testing is below level 4 for Primary students, level 5 for Secondary students. Additional fees have to be paid for these classes.

## Excellent Teaching

MISY international teachers and assistant teachers are well qualified professionals and receive regular in house training and professional development. Our teachers are enthusiastic, they love what they do, which means our students love to learn.

## Learning Materials

MISY uses a wide range of resources to enrich our curriculum, including web based, multimedia or teacher created materials in addition to modern textbooks.

## After School Activities

We will offer a wide range of sporting, creative and engineering activities. These include options such as soccer, basketball, painting and others. We are also planning to offer STEM (Science, Technology, English and Mathematics) construction based classes. The secondary school will set up a community service group as well as sports teams. There will also be after school tutorials and we plan to set up an active student council.

## Mandalay Campus Facilities

The Mandalay campus has big and bright classrooms all air-conditioned, equipped with computers, internet access and overhead projectors. The Early Years' classrooms have a specially designed nap area. There are specialist rooms for Music, Art and Computer classes, a science laboratory, a library, a student canteen, an outdoor playground for small children and a recreational area for older students, a multipurpose covered sport hall, a grass football field, small swimming pools and a parent waiting room.

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
