MISY Mandalay Campus was established in August 2018, providing comprehensive education from Early Years (Nursery and Reception) through to Year 13 (A-Levels), including the IGCSE programme.

A key strength of our campus is our multicultural team, comprising educators and staff from 10 different countries.

We achieved a significant milestone in 2022 by becoming a member of Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE). This allows our students to take the globally recognized University of Cambridge IGCSE and A-Level examinations and engage in international scholastic activities.

In 2025, we are applying for membership from the Council of International Schools (CIS), demonstrating our commitment to upholding globally recognized standards of excellence in international education.

WELCOME TO PRIMARY

Primary consists of Key Stage 1 (Years 1-2) and Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6), with students from ages 5 to 10 respectively.

The English National Curriculum

Primary Students acquire knowledge and skills in line with the National Curriculum in England. We provide a balanced programme which fosters a love for learning that students will carry with them throughout their lives.

Each class is taught by an **experienced expatriate teacher** supported by a well-qualified teaching assistant. All specialist subjects are taught by **specialist teachers**. Students have library lessons and are encouraged to choose books to take home each week.

Oxford Reading Tree

- This reading programme is used to foster early literacy skills. Each level builds on the skills learned before, helping students grow their abilities.

English as an Additional Language

- Students who arrive at MISY with limited English are required to take additional English classes as part of their school day until their level of English improves. We assess their English level using WIDA tests.

Extra Curricular Activities

- **Educational Field Trips**
 - All classes go on educational trips.
- **Cultural and Academic Celebrations**
 - School-wide celebrations showcase learning excellence through performances and exhibitions, such as International Day, Myanmar Culture Day, and Art Exhibitions to name a few.
- **After School Activities (ASAs) and Sports Coaching**
 - We run a programme of exciting after-school activities and sports coaching.



Assessment

Every year, our students sit a CEM Test to check their achievement against their peers in England. Parents receive a detailed report outlining ways to support their child.

Campus Facilities

Primary students all have allocated classrooms. There are specialist rooms for Music, Art, Computing, Myanmar and Mandarin lessons. The outside facilities include a football pitch and several age-appropriate playgrounds.
